- Dec. 2004 Went live

- Case management system
- State job orders

Phase II – Modified MT Works to include

- WIA
- TAA
- Financial Payments
- Completed October, 2007

MT Works — Self Service front end (jobs)

- Used by division staff
- Used by others outside the division / department
- Federal reporting requirements use Dart for federal reporting
