

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 Employer Job Posting Requirement

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) is our nation's aggressive new economic recovery plan designed to jumpstart our economy, create jobs, and help Americans struggling to provide for their families.

The State of Michigan requires that all jobs created as a result of ARRA stimulus funding be posted on the Michigan Talent Bank. To comply with this requirement the grant/contract recipient or any of their sub-grantees/sub-contractors that create or seek to fill positions as a result of the ARRA stimulus funding must:

1. Register (or modify) your free employer account with the Michigan Talent Bank:

2. Answer "yes" to the American Recovery Act (ARRA) funds inquiry:

3. Post and identify all jobs created as a result of ARRA funds on the Michigan Talent Bank by answering "yes" to the ARRA job inquiry:

4. Ensure that the person/s involved in the hiring process post all jobs created as a result of ARRA stimulus funding on the Michigan Talent Bank for no less than 14 days.
5. Enter the Contract/Grant Number for all jobs created with funding for the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. Employers must refer to the Contract/Grant number listed on the ARRA funding agreement.

6. Modify each ARRA job posting by indicating the number of positions filled.
7. Print and maintain a copy of each job posting for no less than 3 years or until audited.

If you incorrectly identify your company as a recipient of ARRA funding, you must contact the Michigan Talent Bank directly to have your status as an ARRA employer changed.
